In this booklet, you will find many notices providing information about the various after school activities for LABBB students. Be sure to look at the forms for specific information regarding each program and send each back by the stated deadline, if interested.

Please take time, together with your child, to go over the activities. Make sure your child wants to attend an event before signing up. Keep in mind that some dates may have to change as the year goes on.

Though after school activities are recommended and encouraged, they are a privilege for students. The LABBB staff reserves the right to restrict student attendance due to behavior at school prior to the event or while a student is attending an activity.

LABBB has a late pick up policy for all of our after school programs. A fee of \$1.00 per minute is charged and payment is expected upon pick-up. It is very important to look at the pick-up times and locations before signing up for an activity to make sure that your student will be able to be picked up on time. Please make sure to alert your cab drivers when your student is not going home on the cab. We have had students leave on their cab when they are signed up for an after school activity.

Read all the enclosed forms carefully and respond by the due dates. Remember to send a **separate check** for each activity. When forms and checks are mailed, please remember to send an e-mail to prizzo@labbb.net. As forms are received, an email confirmation will be sent. If you do not receive a confirmation email, it means the forms did not make it to LABBB.

Activities in this booklet assume we have access to the needed buildings and ability to start on the start dates. Students who sign up will be kept up to date on any changes, including start dates, as needed.



LABBB Afterschool Activities



October 2, 23; November 27; January 29; February 5; March 4, 18, 25; April 1, 29

For students in Lexington High School rooms: 825, 826, 715, 704, 632, 504, Arlington High and Chenery, Ottoson & Marshall Simonds Middle Schools. Students will be transported to Kings Bowladrome at the end of the school day by LABBB vans. Students will receive instruction on the approach, counting balls thrown, and counting pins knocked down. This activity will include dinner each week, (pizza, chicken fingers, salad & drinks at Wegmans). Pick up at Wegmans.

Space for 15 students.

Bingo cards will be sent via email prior to each class. Students may print them out, or use them electronically. Students will log on to zoom and play 3-5 games with their friends, led by a LABBB staff member. We also do some stretching exercises, trivia games, tell us your favorite..., in between games. Winners of the most games at the end of the session, will receive a prize that will be sent via email. Space for 20-25 quests.

Wednesday Dance/Arts Crafts OR Walking/Glee Club

October 4, 11, 18, 25; November 1, 8, 15, 29

Students will be transported in LABBB vans to the Monroe Center on Mass. Ave. in Lexington.

Dance 3:00PM-4:00PM; Arts & Crafts 4:00PM-5:00PM

This will be a structured dance class: warm up, exercises across the floor, and a combination, with the goal of fostering joy, community, and self-esteem through movement. Warm up is based on Brain-Compatible Dance Education (BCDE), a teaching philosophy and internationally recognized methodology that prepares students for learning and may help with social-emotional skills. It is an excellent full body and brain warm up that sequences through eight fundamental movement patterns of early human development and helps to center the brain and body. We will then do a few exercises across the floor, working on gross motor skills, coordination, and moving through the space in different ways. A combination will be taught that we will practice and add to each week. The goal is to have a finished dance to share at the end of the session. Students will have an opportunity to be creative/expressive and connect with each other every class by dancing freely to their favorite songs.

The art class offers opportunities for creative expression in the form of painting and crafting projects. Students will be encouraged to develop freedom of expression while building self-confidence, listening skills, and the ability to work from part to whole in their weekly projects.

Walking Club 3:00PM-4:00PM; Glee Club 4:00PM-5:00PM

This class will walk around the Monroe Center and through the Lexington Cemetery behind the Monroe Center, in all weather, for one hour.

The Glee Club will come together to examine, relate, and learn music in a new way. Together, we will look at music as the universal language it is. Students will be given weekly assignments where we will look at different genres of music, learn about the artists that perform, and discover what these songs mean to us. Students will learn one to two songs as a group, and will have a final performance the last day of the session.

Space for 10 students in each combination (Dance/Arts & Crafts) or (Walking/Glee Club) \$250.00 per student.

LABBB Monthly Activities



Movie Nights (Mondays)

October 2, November 6' December 11, January 29, February 5, March 4, April 1, May 16, June 3.

This activity is for LABBB High School students who are 17 years old and over. Students will need to be dropped off at

the Burlington Cinema around 6:30PM & picked up around 9:00PM. (drop off & pick up times depend on the start & finish times of the movies for that month). Movie selections will be PG-R rated. Students need to sign up in September for the entire year (there will not be sign ups on a monthly basis). Students need to be able to sit through a movie. We will work on independence getting popcorn/drink with each student and going to the bathroom and coming back into the movie theater independently.

Students/parents will be notified of movie choices by email on the Friday before the Monday movie.

Cost is \$260.00 per student for the year and includes movie, popcorn, soda & chaperones each month.



Mini Golf & Games Trips (Fridays after school) September 22, October 13, November 3, December 1, January 19, February. 2, March 22, April 26, May 17, June 7.

This activity is for LABBB Lexington HS students in rooms 821, 822, 825, 826, Bedford HS, Belmont HS and Burlington HS, who enjoy playing mini golf indoors and outdoors. Students will be transported after school to mini golf and back to Lexington High School by LABBB vans. Students will receive instruction on mini golf skills and scoring. Students will not be able to sign up on a monthly basis. Following mini golf, the group will have dinner before returning to Lexington High for pick up. Dinner will be at the site of mini golf or nearby. Students will need to bring cash/debit card with them to pay for dinner. Parent will need to pick up from Lexington High School at approximately 6:30PM

Students/parents will be notified of location by e-mail on the Monday before the Friday trip.

Cost is **\$160.00 per student** for the year and includes: chaperones and 10 sessions of mini golf. Space limited to 15 students.

In 2014, Bedford High School won both the Massachusetts and the National Best Buddies Chapters of the year.
